The Community Law Project at California Western School of Law has received a \$20,000 grant from the Parker Foundation to support the project's five free legal clinics around the county. The clinics provide citizens access to the legal system that they could not afford otherwise and are located in downtown San Diego, two in City Heights, and in the cities of Lemon Grove and Solana Beach.

"We are incredibly appreciative of the foundation's support and confidence in our work and know that this grant will assist us in providing much-needed legal services to people in need throughout San Diego County," said Executive Director Dana Sisitsky. During 2014, the clinics provided legal services and community education presentations to more than 759 people — much of it through one-on-one meetings.
